



Medieval Studies Secondary Field Worksheet

The secondary field in medieval studies requires four graduate courses (200-level), one of which must be in paleography, plus the fulfillment of one language requirement in medieval Latin, Greek, Hebrew, or Arabic.

The **paleography requirement** can be fulfilled by taking Medieval Studies 201 (offered every three years), Medieval Studies 202 (offered every other year), Classics 277, or another course approved by the Committee. The **language requirement** will be fulfilled by examination, administered by the committee on an annual basis. The **graduate course requirement** can be fulfilled with any three 200-level courses in a medieval subject. Each course must be in a different department, one of which may be the student's home department.
