1. Student information form (available at the "Undergraduate Program" page of the Medieval Studies Committee website, or from the Program office);
2. a one-page abstract of the thesis project;
3. the thesis paper, including any images, appendices, and/or apparatus;
4. departmental readers' comments (if available).

All materials are due by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, 5 April 2019. Applications may be submitted electronically, in PDF format, to the Medieval Studies Committee (medieval@fas.harvard.edu); alternatively, two copies of all forms may be delivered to the Committee's office, at Barker Center 120. **In addition, please arrange for one letter of recommendation (either from the thesis chair or another faculty adviser) to be sent to the Medieval Studies Committee office by the application deadline.**
